STRATEGIC PLAN 2020-2022

The ISONG Board and all ISONG Committees participated in an intensive strategic planning project from November 2019 through February 2020. Just at the plan came into its final phase, the world was thrust into a global pandemic. Although much in our lives has changed, from online education, shortages of personal protective equipment, government mandates and limits on social gatherings, ISONG has remained a strong and supportive community of genetic nurses and related healthcare professionals.

While the world as we know it has certainly changed, the overall strategic goals of ISONG have not. The Board and Committee Chairs identified four overarching strategic goals for the organization:

- 1. Expand Educational Resources
- 2. Increase Membership

- 3. Increase Visibility of ISONG and Nurses
- 4. Create Formal Partnerships

These four goals will guide ISONG activity between 2020-2022 and should serve as a roadmap for projects that might be undertaken by the ISONG Board, all ISONG committees, and ISONG members who are actively participating on committees.

All committees identified specific projects and activities that align with ISONG's four strategic goals. The outcome of those ideas is depicted in this summary document and will assist ISONG in working toward the achievement of its mission and goals through 2022.
